## Remaining Fruit

*John 15:16 "Ye have not chosen me, but I have chosen you, and ordained you, that ye should go bring forth fruit, and that your fruit should remain: that whatsoever ye shall ask of the Father in my name, he may give it you."*

God has chosen us and set us apart to be fruitful. We should give all that we have to be fruitful. What kind of fruit?

- 1) Fruit of Souls (Rom. 1:13) - People won to Christ
- 2) Fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22,23) - Evidence of genuine Christian character
- 3) Fruit of our Speech (Heb. 13:15) - The evidence of praise on our lips
- 4) Fruit of Righteousness (Rom. 6:21) - Right living

As an evangelist, I witness many people making decisions for Christ. I am always concerned as to what happens to these people in the long term. Do they remain or fall away? God desires remaining fruit. I have been greatly encouraged the past few weeks as I have meet with a number of people who have made professions of faith in our evangelism outreach. involved in a Bible study. Despite being hospitalized for cancer treatment the man asked doctors permission to leave the hospital to attend our special meetings at Sunrise Baptist Church last week. Praise the Lord!

I returned home from Harmony, Maine last night. We conducted special meetings there over the weekend. Several people attended the meetings who earlier made professions of faith during our outreach. One man does door-to-door visitation and has shared his faith on the streets of Montreal. He is an evangelist who has a real passion for those who are lost. Another lady I lead to Christ has been baptized and is vitally concerned about her community. She has used a clothing ministry to reach out to the lost. Another young lady I led to Christ one year ago in that church was there yesterday. She is following Christ and will marry a fine young Christian man in January. There were others in the meeting who were saved during past evangelistic thrusts who have been baptized and shared how God is at work in their lives.

Thank you Lord that this is your work. Thank you for showing me the remaining fruit so as to encourage my heart. Praise your name.
