African Advance

The Furtherance name is derived from Philippians 1:12 - "But I would you should understand, brethren, that the things which have happened unto me have fallen out rather for the furtherance of the gospel." It carries with it the idea of advancement. The word Furtherance in the Bible means ADVANCE. It has the idea of army engineers making a way through difficult terrain for the deployment of troops. The image that comes to mind is someone with a machete cutting a path through thick brush to open a way for the deployment of troops. There is an emphasis on reaching unreached areas. "I would never build on another man's foundation. I shall preach the gospel beyond every other man's line of things." Missionary David Livingstone. Livingstone was the first European explorer to discover and map out Lake Nyasa in Malawi. Blantyre, Malawi's commercial capital is named after the town of Livingstone's birth in Scotland. We will be staying in this city on our mission trip.

Furtherance Ministries, in addition to home missions, has sought to reach out to people who have not been evangelized or people who have little evangelization. We have worked in Bosnia on two occasions and Northern Canada amongst the Cree people for some 30 years.

Furtherance Ministries has been working with Pastor Pyton Nyandula since September 2020. God has used him to plant nine churches. Many people have been saved and baptized.

Furtherance Ministries has:

- Provided monthly support to Pastor Pyton and family.
- Set up a chicken coop with 150 chickens in one area.
- Purchased sewing machines to help people generate income.
- Purchased a Multimedia Projector, which is being used to show the 'Jesus' video in villages. It is also used in the preschool.
- A preschool has been started called the 'Hannah Preschool'.
- A gospel tract has been translated into their language.
- A vehicle, printer, computer, iPhone for Pastor Pyton and bicycles for some of the other Pastors.
- We have provided food and helped people get back into their houses after the devastation of Cyclone Freddy, which caused so much death and devastation in this area.

Our project **African Advance** is going to take place on September 4 – 16, 2023. Our goals are as follows:

- 1. To preach the Gospel in several Evangelistic Outreaches throughout Malawi.
- 2. To train national pastors. We have seen nine churches planted by Pastor Pyton Nyandula in the past several years.
- 3. To survey the area to find ways to create work opportunities so the church can be self supporting.

We had planned on a larger team, but God has led us to follow Joshua's example of sending two spies to spy out the land. Pastor Paul Moses, a Cree pastor from Waskaganish, Quebec and Ed Sealy, founder and president of Furtherance Ministries will be making the trip. We get to see this area with our own eyes and as a result, will be much more effective in how we minister in the future. We are praying that some of our Cree brothers and sisters in Christ in Northern Canada will be led to be involved in missions in a greater way. We pray we might see some of them become missionaries themselves.

Introducing Paul Moses of the African Advance Team Paul Pastor's Waskaganish Cree Gospel Fellowship



A bit of Paul's testimony: Through the help of close friends, relatives, and counseling, it wasn't till I was a married man with children that I began to see the things I had to deal with. I had covered things up and I had to let God get in touch with my pain and hurt. I had to allow others to help. It's especially my wife, Hannah, who has helped me find healing and freedom. She has shown God's grace and transformation power.

In 1990, there was no one else to take on leadership at our Waskaganish Cree Gospel Fellowship in Quebec, so I stepped forward. Getting to that point in life was not quick and easy, but I

had significant Christian men in my life. They were role models for me and even when I was down and out they were there for me. They prayed for me and they challenged me. There were the Cheechoo's, the Jolly's, John Beck, and others. Some of them had previously been into alcohol, but I saw the change in their lives. I watched them get involved in ministry, go off to Bible School, then serve in ministry around Canada and some of them coming back to serve in the local church.

There were several missionaries, too, who nudged me towards God when other voices were telling me to give up. Some of them rebuked me on occasion and I needed that too!

Learning To Serve - As a teen I remember being asked to get the stoves going at the church each Sunday. It wasn't much, but I was learning church responsibility and there was satisfaction knowing that people could come to a warm place. Then I was asked to teach a Sunday School class, then asked if I could lead a service. I still remember the first time I was asked, "Can you preach the message?". I remember wondering how I, a hurting boy, could be asked to do these things. I think some of my mentors were ready to give up on me sometimes, but they still believed in me. These missionaries and Christian men gave me a vision for the church.

As a pastor, I remember feeling overwhelmed by past hurts and wanting to resign. I hadn't given up on the Christian life, just on being a Pastor. I remember talking to four men about it. They all knew my weaknesses, but they didn't say, "Well, you gave it a shot." They said, "Paul, you have a Pastor's heart." I said, "What?" They said, "We'll support you. We'll stand by you." I had given up on myself, but God hadn't and I needed to become willing to walk in God's grace.
